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## ***2nd Hong Kong Primary School and Kindergarten Driving Range Open***

**Purpose:** To provide an opportunity for younger age students to participate in golf competition, as well as raise their awareness on physical activity.

**Date:** 1<sup>st</sup> May 2019 (Wed, Public Holiday)

**Venue:** Olympic Golf Waterfall Driving Range

**Time:** 1000-1600

**Eligibility:** Full time/half-day primary & kindergarten students

**Participants:**

- (1) Participants should join the division according to their grade.
- (2) Participants must complete all the four events from A to D. Otherwise they will be disqualified.
- (3) Eligibility for participation is non-transferable.
- (4) Entry fees are non-refundable to participants who are absent or disqualified.

Format:

Participants should compete a total of four events; (A) Target Distance, (B) Bunker, (C) Chipping & Putting & (D) Pitching

(A) Target Distance

Participants are required to hit 10 balls from a specified bay to two targets (Approximately 40 yards and 70 yards). 5 chances for each target, total 10 shots 3 points each, the total point of this task is 30

(B) Bunker

Participants are required to hit out 5 balls from the specified bunker to the target. 3 point for each that lands on the target. The total point for this task is 20.

(C) Chipping and putting

Participants are required to do chip and putt from the specified area. Participants need to perform this task 2 times. The number of strokes of each ball will indicate the points. The total point of this task is 30, the details are as follow:

(D) Pitching

Participants are required to hit 5 balls to the basket (Approximately 10 yards). The participants who hit the ball into the basket will get 4 point each. The total point of this task is 20.

Awards:

Prizes will be awarded to the Champion, 1st and 2nd runners-up of each division and team division. Active participation award will be given for the school that has the highest number of participants.

Adjudication  
On the winner:

The total score of four tasks is 100. In case of ties in each division, the total score of each event from A to D will be compared until the winner is decided. If the participants get the same total scores in each event, the winner will be decided by competition of putting context. Participant's ball which is nearer to the hole will be the final winner.

Rules of  
Competition:

(1) Participants should arrive at the venue and report to the Organizer 15 minutes before the scheduled time for the first event. They must show valid identity documents for verification of their names. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any participants who fail to prove his/her identity.

(2) Participants should arrive at the course on the scheduled time and report to the staff of the Organizer. Participants failing to report within the first 5 minutes of the specified time for the competition will be regarded as giving up of their participating right.

(3) Participants should obey the rules of the golf driving range and practice green of the Waterfall Golf Driving Range.

(4) Participants should finish the games within the time limit during the competition.

(5) Participants are not allowed to accept “advice” from anyone after they have entered the range. “Advice” means any hints given which may affect the participants’ judgement such as the choice of clubs, alignment and ball flight direction etc.

(6) Please keep silence when the competition is in progress.

(7) Participants may choose to use the rubber tees provided by the Organizer in Event A “Target Distance”.

(8) Ready ball accidentally moved by the participant’s club before stroke will be counted as ball of the event. Air shot will also be counted as ball of the event during the competition.

(9) Subject to the terms stated in this prospectus, the rules and regulations currently adopted by “The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland” and “The United States Golf Association” will be applied.

(10) No appeal will be allowed. The decision of the judge on the site is final.

(11) The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any participant who is in breach of the rules and regulations or engages in unbecoming conduct that may affect the progress of the competition. The participant’s scores will be cancelled and the fee paid will not be refunded.

(12) Participants should take care of their personal belongings.

Judge: The Australian Golf Academy’s coaches and workers will be invited for the competition judging services.

Postponement: If typhoon signal No. 3 or above, or the red or black rainstorm warning signal is issued before 7:00am on the event day, the competitions on that day will be cancelled and we will announce the postponed date as soon as possible.

Enrollment Period: 23<sup>th</sup> March 2019 11:00 am to 23<sup>th</sup> April 2019 06:00 pm

Enrollment Method: (1) Enrolment on a first-come-first-served basis: In Person: Applicants should return the completed enrolment forms, together with their entry fees, to the Olympic Golf Waterfall Driving Range to complete the enrolment procedures. At the time of enrolment, applicants must show their identity documents (original or copy) for verification.

(2) For applications received on the same day, priority will be accorded to the applicants who enroll in person.
